GIFTS AT WORK

Funds raised over the last 6 months have contributed to the purchase of new medical equipment for various areas of TADH. Here are a few highlights:

Workstations on wheels - WoW's

Teams on the medical floors gain mobility/access at the bedside; WoW's also reduce nursing staff and physicians' trips to the main desk allowing for more time with patients!

Colonoscopes

These flexible tubes with tiny cameras allow physicians improved view of the entire colon. Important to investigate intestinal issues.

Intelliguard pharmacy system

An automated restocking and management system of pharmaceutical items in crash carts or anesthesia trays. These urgent response kits can be checked in 3 minutes compared to 40 minutes.
